Holy Spirit Parishioners,

This year the annual “**Feeding of the Multitude**” will be held at St. John’s Episcopal Church on Maybank Highway. This annual event provides a hearty meal and good fellowship to approximately 3000 residents of Johns and Wadmalaw Islands. Meals are served both on site and through home delivery. This is a large event and requires the work of numerous volunteers. Holy Spirit parishioners have been generous with their time and efforts over previous years and we anticipate that this year will be no different.

The event will be held on Saturday November 17, 2018. Meals will be served from 12 noon through to 3 pm. Meals will be delivered to homes earlier beginning at 10 am. Volunteers are requested to fill a number of positions. These include home delivery volunteers, greeters, host/hostesses, platers, servers, clean up, parking and a post dinner clean up and break down. Volunteers will be asked to fill in for approximately ninety minutes. Food donations are also needed. All turkeys and hams will be provided by Holy Spirit but volunteers to prepare side dishes are requested. The side dishes are sweet potatoes, dressing, rice, green beans, cranberry sauce and desserts which do not require refrigeration. **Due to dietary restrictions, volunteers preparing side dishes will be required to use a recipe provided by FTM.**

Many items are purchased for this event. These include plates, napkins, silverware, trash bags, signs and other necessary items. Donations will be greatly appreciated.
